2020 Kayak Regatta - Sunday, September 6th @ 1 p.m.

Kayakers and canoers of all ages and skill levels are invited to join the **6th Annual Kayak Regatta**. The Regatta will launch on the rising tide, at 1 p.m., Sunday, September 6th.. The launch site is the **State of CT Great Island Boat Launch** at the end of **Smith Neck Rd. Old Lyme** (turn off Rte 156 opposite Mile Creek Rd).



The route will lead us up the Back River, then cut between Marvin Island and Great Island, both part of the Roger Tory Peterson Preserve. We will then travel to a large open bay between two smaller islands for an exploration of the Duck River. From here, there will be scenic views of the Old Lyme Land Trust's Elizabeth B. Karter Watch Rock Preserve. Along the way, we will point out special features of the area and the Watch Rock Preserve.

The tour will return to the boat launch at approximately 3:30 p.m.,
where light refreshments will be served.
